On September 16, 2009, a representative of the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency inspected Comprenew Environmental located in Grand Rapids, Michigan (Comprenew). The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate Comprenew's compliance with certain requirements of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), specifically the Conditional Exclusions for Used, Broken Cathode Ray Tubes (CRTs) and Processed CRT Glass Undergoing Recycling; and Used, Intact CRTs Exported for Recycling set forth at 40 CFR §§ 261.39 and 261.40, respectively. Enclosed please find a copy of our inspection report dated October 8, 2009.

As of this writing, based upon information available to EPA, our review of the inspection has not resulted in the detection of violations of any of the specific RCRA requirements under evaluation. This determination does not limit the applicability of the requirements evaluated, other RCRA regulations, or regulations under other environmental statutes. EPA and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) will continue to evaluate your facility in the future.
